Take I-70 to exit 49 (CO 65, Powderhorn exit) go east on CO 65 (10 Miles) to Highway 330 (watch for Collbran sign) go east on Highway 330 to Collbran (11 miles). As you come into Collbran turn right at the first street, 58 1/2 Road go straight 2 miles and follow signs to Bonham Reservoir.
